

HSLC NAMING OPPORTUNITIES

The new James Cook Animal Shelter and Adoption center on Highway 70 was made possible through the generosity of many donors to the HSLC Capital Campaign. Donors may sponsor cat and dog kennels with annual donations under \$500. With major gifts of \$10,000 or more, donors may more permanently "name" rooms or areas inside the shelter, or "memorialize" loved ones in our Memorial Park and exterior grounds.
